Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 35-A MRSA c. 44, as amended, is repealed.

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SUMMARY

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This bill repeals the Maine Surplus Energy Auction Program. Only one utility qualified for surplus sales under the statute and no bids were received in that instance.

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
