COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 602, L.D. 827, Bill, "An Act to Authorize Corporate Officers to Represent Their Corporation in Certain Civil Actions in District Court"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 4 MRSA §807, sub-§3, ¶J, as enacted by PL 1995, c. 599, §3, is amended to read:

J. For the purposes of defending a civil action filed against a corporation, an officer of the corporation if the corporation is organized in this State and has 2 5 or fewer shareholders.'

SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill. The current law authorizes an officer of a Maine corporation to represent the corporation in court to defend a civil action if the corporation has 2 or fewer shareholders. This amendment increases that limit to 5 shareholders.
