	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 24-A MRSA §14 is enacted to read:
4	<u>§14. Information concerning school administrative unit's</u>
6	experience rating
8	Notwithstanding any provisions of law governing confidentiality to the contrary, an insurer shall supply
10	information concerning a school administrative unit's own experience rating and claims history to that school
12	administrative unit at its request and to the municipality in which the unit is located if the municipality so requests.

16	SUMMARY
18	This bill allows school administrative units to engage in competitive bidding by ensuring that school administrative units
20	have access to their own experience ratings and claims history. This bill requires that insurers provide such information to
22	school administrative units at their request, regardless of the identity of the insurers' official clients, and to the
24	municipalities in which the school unit is located if the municipality so requests.

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
