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Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §3174-I, sub-§4 is enacted to read:

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4. Total care cost analysis. In performing assessments under subsections 1 and 1-A, the department shall include total care cost calculations, including but not limited to the cost of all support services needed by the client in a variety of settings, including housekeeping services and home expenses, drugs and food. The client may choose among the total care options that are determined to be clinically appropriate and within 90% of others in cost.

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## **SUMMARY**

This bill requires the Department of Human Services to calculate the total care costs for long-term care services. 18 allows the client to choose between total care options determined to be clinically appropriate and costing within 90% of each other. 20
