	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2602, sub-§4, as enacted by PL 1993, c.
4	683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is repealed and the
	following enacted in its place:

	4. Fines. Fines and forfeitures collected under this Title
8	are distributed as follows:
10	A. Two percent of the money received accrues to the law
	enforcement agency that issued the summons and complaint.
12	The amount received by the local law enforcement agency may
14	be used only for technical purposes, including, but not
14	limited to, the purchase of computer equipment; and
16	B. The remaining money accrues to the General Fund, except
10	that, of each fine or forfeiture collected under sections
18	511, 2356, 2360, 2380, 2387 and 2388, only \$5 or 13%,
	whichever is greater, accrues to the General Fund and the
20	balance accrues to the Highway Fund.

26	This bill returns 2% of all fines collected for motor
	vehicle moving violations to the law enforcement agency charging
28	the person with the moving violation and that money will be used
20	only for technical purposes such as the purchase of computer
