2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2385, sub-§4** is enacted to read:

6 4. **Snowplows.** A snowplow engaged in plowing state or town
8 roads must display a reflector or reflective material on the end
10 of a plow wing that extends out to the road and faces oncoming
12 traffic.

14 **SUMMARY**

This bill requires that snowplows engaged in plowing state or town roads have reflectors on the plow wing that faces oncoming traffic.
