SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 626, L.D. 851, Bill, "An Act Directing the Department of Human Services to Apply for a Medicaid Waiver to Allow Spouses to Be Paid as Personal Care Attendants"

Amend the amendment in section 2 by striking out all of the last 2 lines (page 2, lines 28 and 29 in amendment) and inserting in their place the following:

This amendment includes General Fund deappropriations of \$131,691 and \$138,172 in fiscal years 1997-98 and 1998-99, respectively, from the Department of Human Services to offset the General Fund appropriations required by the bill.
