Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §1760, sub-§78 is enacted to read:

78. Motor vehicle modifications for person with disability. Modifications to a motor vehicle that allow it to be accessible to or operated by an individual with a disability, including, but not limited to, wheel chair lifts and adaptive control equipment. SUMMARY

This bill creates a sales tax exemption for modifications to 14 a motor vehicle that make it accessible to and operable by a person with a disability.
