

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 35-A MRSA §7307** is enacted to read:

6 **§7307. Basic service calling areas**

8 By January 1, 1998, the commission shall adopt rules
10 permitting telephone utility customers to make unlimited calls
12 between locations within municipalities within a school
14 administrative unit, as defined in Title 20-A, section 1,
16 subsection 26, for a flat monthly rate. Rules adopted pursuant
18 to this section are routine technical rules as defined in Title
20 5, chapter 375, subchapter II-A.

16 **SUMMARY**

18 This bill requires the Public Utilities Commission to adopt
20 rules allowing customers with a school administrative unit to
make unlimited calls within the unit for a flat monthly rate.
