be it enacted by the reopie of the State of Maine as follows:
Sec. 1. 35-A MRSA §7307 is enacted to read:
§7307. Basic service calling areas
By January 1, 1998, the commission shall adopt rule:
permitting telephone utility customers to make unlimited calls
between locations within municipalities within a school
administrative unit, as defined in Title 20-A, section 1
subsection 26, for a flat monthly rate. Rules adopted pursuant
to this section are routine technical rules as defined in Title
5, chapter 375, subchapter II-A.

This bill requires the Public Utilities Commission to adoptive allowing customers with a school administrative unit to
make unlimited calls within the unit for a flat monthly rate
