Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §5401, sub-§12, as enacted by PL 1981, c. 693, §§5 and 8, is amended to read:

12. Safety. Transportation-provided chall-conserve—the comfort,—safety—and—welfare—of—the—students—conveyed. A responsible driver shall must be in charge of the vehicle and shall-have—control-over—the—conduct—of—the—students—while—they are—transported. The school administrative unit shall provide additional appropriate personnel, as necessary, to accommodate students with special needs and to ensure the comfort, safety and welfare of all students conveyed.
