	This bill establishes the same party enrollment
14	qualifications for replacement candidates to certain state
	offices as exist for candidates for primary nomination under the
16	Maine Revised Statutes, Title 21-A, section 334. Under this
	bill, a replacement nominee must be enrolled in the same
18	political party as the original candidate by March 15th.

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
