30	'Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7452, sub-§6, as enacted by PL 1979, c. 420,

34	6. Failure to register bear. A person is guilty of failure to register a bear if he <u>that person</u> :
36	A. Possesses a bear which that has not been legally
38	registered as provided in section 7451 except in accordance with chapter 709, subchapter IV;

42	B. Kills a bear and fails to present it for registration in his that person's name at the first open bear registration station on the route taken by him that person; or

12	This bill may reduce prosecutions for Class E crimes. It jail sentences are reduced, the savings to the counties are		
14	estimated to be \$83.78 per day per prisoner. These savings do not affect reimbursement by the State. The reduction in the		
16	number of prosecutions that would have resulted in a jail sentence and the resulting savings to the county jail system are		
18	expected to be insignificant.		
20	The Judicial Department may realize some minor savings from reductions of workload and administrative costs associated with		
22	the minimal number of cases that will no longer be filed in the court system. Reductions in the collection of fines may decrease
