Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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	Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §52, as amended by PL 1973, c. 625, §128, is
4	further amended by adding a new paragraph at the end to read:
б	In order to promote engineering and design quality and ensure maximum competition by firms providing consultant
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0	services, the department may adopt its own guidelines for
	determining the reasonableness and permissability of various cost
10	factors including, but not limited to, salary limits, benefits and expense reimbursement. Notwithstanding any other federal or
12	state law to the contrary, the department's guidelines must be
	utilized in lieu of federally mandated provisions.
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18	SUMMARY
20	This bill allows the Department of Transportation to
	continue its current practice of establishing guidelines to
22	promote engineering and design quality and to ensure maximum
	competition by firms providing consultant services. This bill is
24	in response to Section 307 of the 1995 National Highway System
	Designation Act that requires Maine to enact legislation in order

to continue Maine's current policies and practices.

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
