

2 **Sec. 1. Public Utilities Commission directed to reform NYNEX**
3 **Schools and Libraries Project. Resolved:** That the Public Utilities
4 Commission is directed to reform its order of January 5, 1996 in
5 Docket 94-123, which created the NYNEX Schools and Libraries
6 Project. The Public Utilities Commission shall permit any school
7 participating in the project to choose the equipment and services
8 that it receives and to choose to convert any portion of the cost
9 of equipment or services that it is eligible to receive under the
10 project into a reduced telephone rate.

12 **SUMMARY**

14 This resolve requires the Public Utilities Commission to
15 revise the NYNEX Schools and Libraries Project to permit any
16 school participating in the project to choose the nature of the
17 equipment and services that it receives and to choose to convert
18 any portion of cost of equipment or services that it is eligible
 to receive under the project into a reduced telephone rate.
