Sec. 1. Public Utilities Commission directed to reform NYNEX Schools and Libraries Project. Resolved: That the Public Utilities Commission is directed to reform its order of January 5, 1996 in Docket 94-123, which created the NYNEX Schools and Libraries Project. The Public Utilities Commission shall permit any school participating in the project to choose the equipment and services that it receives and to choose to convert any portion of the cost of equipment or services that it is eligible to receive under the project into a reduced telephone rate.
