Other Telecommunications Equipment for People with Disabilities, 4 referred to in this resolve as the "commission," is established; and be it further 6 Sec. 2. Commission membership. Resolved: That the commission 8 consists of the following 12 members: 10 1. One member of the Senate, appointed by the President of the Senate; 12 2. One member of the House of Representatives, appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives; 14 16 3. One representative of the Public Advocate; 18 4. One representative of the Public Protection Division within the Office of the Attorney General; 20 5. One representative of a deaf advocacy organization, 22 appointed by the Governor; 24 6. One representative of disability advocacy а organization, appointed by the Governor; 26 7. Three representatives of telephone companies providing phone service within the State including one representative of 28 independent telephone companies, appointed by the Governor; and 30 8. Three members of the general public who currently use or 32 plan use teletypewriters or special telecommunications to equipment for persons with disabilities, appointed by the Governor; and be it further 34 Sec. 3. Convening of commission. **Resolved**: 36 That all appointments must be made no later than 30 days after the The Chair of the Legislative effective date of this resolve. 38 Council shall call the first meeting within 14 days after all appointments are made. Sec. 4. Duties. Resolved: That the commission shall study the following:

1. The current use and distribution of teletypewriters and other telecommunications equipment for persons with disabilities
in the State, including the current loaner program;

2. The use and distribution of teletypewriters and other

 other states, including, but not limited to, the financing of
 teletypewriters and other telecommunications equipment and the
 type of equipment currently being used; and

3. The compliance requirements of the federal Americans
with Disabilities Act of 1990 regarding the use of
teletypewriters and other telecommunications equipment;

Sec. 5. Report. Resolved: That the commission shall prepare a written report of its findings and submit the report, together with any necessary implementing legislation, within 30 days after the convening of the Second Regular Session of the 118th Legislature. If the commission requires an extension, it may apply to the Legislative Council, which may grant the extension; and be it further

34 Sec. 6. Staff assistance. Resolved: That the commission shall request staff assistance from the Legislative Council; and be it 36 further;

Sec. 7. Compensation. Resolved: That the members of the commission are entitled to reimbursement for travel and other
 necessary expenses upon application to the Legislative Council. The Executive Director of the Legislative Council shall
 administer the commission's budget.

SUMMARY

This resolve establishes the Commission to Study the Funding and Distribution of Teletypewriters and Other Telecommunications Equipment for People with Disabilities. The commission will review the current system of distribution and funding of the equipment and explore alternatives, including programs in other
states and distribution through telecommunications companies.
The commission will also explore alternative funding mechanisms
for expansion of the current loaner program that will include the use of additional equipment.
