HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 294, L.D. 945, Bill, "An Act to Establish Basic Standards and Procedures for Personal Services Contracting by the State"


Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§1816-A." by inserting after subsection 1 the following:

'2. Personal services contracting required. Personal services contracting is required when a state agency must hire additional labor that otherwise would result in the creation of a new position and all the conditions in subsection 3 are met. Personal services contracting is not required to fill an existing position.'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§1816-A." by renumbering the subsections to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment requires personal services contracting when a state agency must hire additional labor that otherwise would result in the creation of a new position and the conditions required for permissible personal services contracting are met.
