4 Sec. 1. 30-A MRSa §101, sub-§5-A is enacted to read:

6 5-A. Hire road commissioner. Hire a person with suitable  
8 expertise in road and bridge building and maintenance as a  
full-time or part-time working road commissioner for the county  
when, in their discretion, it is determined necessary;

12 This bill authorizes county commissioners to hire a  
14 qualified person to serve as county road commissioner.
