An Act to Require the State to Recognize Moose Hunting Permits Issued by the Passamaquoddy Tribe.

Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7463-A, sub-§14 is enacted to read:

14. Moose hunting permits issued by the Passamaquoddy Tribe. Notwithstanding subsection 4, a tribal subsistence moose hunting permit issued by the Passamaquoddy Tribe authorizes the permit holder to hunt moose during the open season on moose in any moose hunting district or zone established by the commissioner. The bag limit on lands outside Indian territory for a person hunting under the provisions of this subsection is one moose.

Sec. 2. 30 MRSA §6207, sub-§1-A is enacted to read:

1-A. Moose hunting permits. Tribal subsistence moose hunting permits issued by the Passamaquoddy Tribe authorize the holder to hunt moose during the open season on moose in any moose hunting district or zone established by the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife under Title 12, section 7463-A. Holders of tribal subsistence moose hunting permits are subject to the same requirements and restrictions that apply to holders of moose hunting permits issued under Title 12, section 7463-A.

SUMMARY

This bill ensures that tribal subsistence moose hunting permits issued by the Passamaquoddy Tribe to members of the Passamaquoddy Tribe are valid and accepted by the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife. Holders of permits will be able to hunt moose within all moose hunting districts and zones, but are otherwise subject to the restrictions and requirements that apply to holders of moose hunting permits issued by the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife. The bag limit is one moose.
