COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 698, L.D. 962, Bill, "An Act to Make the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife an Elected Position"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The bill may have cost implications during primary and general elections beginning in fiscal year 1998-99 if a 2nd ballot is required to accommodate all of the elected officials due to the limited space on the ballots. The cost of adding a 2nd ballot is \$95,000.'

This amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
