HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 703, L.D. 967, Bill, "An Act to Expand Recycling through Reduced Burning"

Amend the amendment in section 7 by striking out all of subsection 6 (page 4, lines 22 to 26 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'6. Compensation. The members of the task force who are Legislators are entitled to receive the legislative per diem as defined in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 3, section 2 and reimbursement for travel and other necessary expenses for attendance at meetings of the task force. Other members are not entitled to compensation or reimbursement of expenses.'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 9 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 9. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
