12	This chapter may be known and cited as the "Rider Safety Act."
14	§802. Definitions

20	1. Amusement owner. "Amusement owner" means a person, the State or a political subdivision of the State that owns an amusement ride or, if the amusement ride is leased, the lessee.

16	1. Reports. A rider or the rider's parent or guardian shall report in writing to the amusement owner or the amusement
18	owner's designee any injury sustained on an amusement ride before leaving the amusement owner's premises, including:

22	A. The name, address and phone number of the injured person;
24	B. A brief description of the incident, the injury claimed and the location, date and time of the injury:
26	C. The cause of the injury, if known; and
28	D. The names, addresses and phone numbers of any witnesses to the incident.
30	If the rider or the rider's parent or quardian is unable to file
32	a report because of the severity of the rider's injuries, the rider or the rider's parent or guardian shall file the report as
34	soon as reasonably possible. The failure of a rider or the rider's parent or guardian to report an injury under this section

40	A. Obey the reasonable safety rules posted in accordance with this Act and oral instructions for an amusement ride

This bill enacts the Rider Safety Act to delineate safe conduct by amusement ride riders. It sets forth a code of conduct for amusement ride riders, a requirement for the reporting of injuries sustained on amusement rides to amusement owners, qualifications for those riding amusement rides and a requirement for the posting by amusement owners of instructional signs. The bill provides criminal penalties for violations of the Rider Safety Act.
