	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 3 MRSA §162, sub-§1, as repealed and replaced by PL
4	1973, c. 590, §4, is amended to read:
6	1. Legislative budgets. To prepare-and-approve administer all legislative budgets approved pursuant to section 162-C;
8	Sec. 2. 3 MRSA §162-C is enacted to read:
10.	§162-C. Legislative budget process

14	The budget for the Legislature as proposed by the legislative budget committee established in subsection 1 must be
16	approved by a 2/3 vote of each House of the Legislature.
18	1. Legislative budget committee. The legislative budget committee is established for each regular session of the
20	Legislature and consists of the Legislative Council and 2 members of the Senate, each one representing a different major party, appointed by the President of the Senate and 2 members of the
22	House of Representatives, each one representing a different major party, appointed by the Speaker of the House. The committee
24	shall hold public meetings and notification of these meetings must be included in the advance journal and calendar or written
26	supplements of each House of the Legislature.
28	2. Proposed line-item budget. The committee shall develop a proposed line-item budget and distribute the proposed budget to
30	all Legislators for review.
32	3. Budget and budget records open to the public. The legislative budget and budget records are public records.

36	SUMMARY
38	This bill amends the budget process for the Legislature's budget. It establishes a legislative budget committee consisting
40	of legislative leadership and 2 additional members of the Senate and 2 additional members of the House of Representatives. The
42	proposed budget developed by the legislative budget committee must be approved by a 2/3 vote of each body of the Legislature.
44	All records of the Legislature's budget proceedings are open to the public.
