4 **Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §17001, sub-§42, ¶B,** as amended by PL 1995, c.
471, §1, is further amended to read:

6 B. Any employee of a public school who fills any position
not included in paragraph A, the principal function of which
8 is to introduce new learning to students, except that a
part-time or substitute teacher or coach or an employee who
10 is employed in adult education as defined in Title 20-A,
section 8601-A, subsection 1 and who is not otherwise
12 covered by the definition of teacher defined in this
subsection may not be considered a teacher for purposes of
14 this Part;
