B. Any employee of a public school who fills any position not included in paragraph A, the principal function of which is to introduce new learning to students, except that a part-time or substitute teacher or coach or an employee who is employed in adult education as defined in Title 20-A, section 8601-A, subsection 1 and who is not otherwise covered by the definition of teacher defined in this subsection may not be considered a teacher for purposes of this Part;
