'Further amend the bill in section 5 in that part designated "\$7056-A." by inserting at the end of subsection 4 the following new blocked paragraph:

'As used in this subsection, political activity means to advocate expressly for the election or defeat of any candidate for a federal office, a constitutional office or any candidate for partisan elective municipal, county or state office, including leadership positions in the Senate and the House of Representatives or to solicit contributions reportable under Title 21-A, chapter 13.'

Further amend the amendment by inserting before the summary the following:

'8. Exemption of official duties. This section may not be construed to apply to any actions taken in order to carry out the duties and responsibilities of an officer's or employee's position, including but not limited to advocacy on policy issues or legislation.

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.'
