2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §1482, sub-§4, ¶A is enacted to read:**

6 A. At the time of payment of the excise tax prior to a new
8 registration for a new passenger vehicle purchased from a
10 motor vehicle dealer licensed in any state for the sale of
12 new passenger vehicles, the owner shall submit the
14 manufacturer's suggested retail price sticker, or a copy of
16 the sticker, to the excise tax collector.

18 This paragraph applies only to those vehicles for which a
20 manufacturer's suggested retail price sticker is required by
22 the Federal Government.

SUMMARY

This bill requires that purchasers of vehicles required to have a manufacturer's suggested retail price sticker, the "Monroney label," be required to bring the sticker to the municipal excise tax collector.
