## 10 FISCAL NOTE

The General Fund cost to the Department of Mental Health, Mental Retardation and Substance Abuse Services associated with extending the end dates of certain positions from May 31, 1997 to May 31, 1998 will be supported through financial order transfers existing budgeted resources. The department will experience an increase Special in Other Revenue disproportionate share hospital payments due to the increase in costs at the Augusta Mental Health Institute. The total cost to the General Fund and Other Special Revenue, should the positions be extended for the full 12 months, would be approximately \$1,250,000.
