FISCAL NOTE

This initiated bill has no fiscal impact, if enacted without change. If it is amended or rejected by the Legislature, this bill must be sent out to referendum. The estimated cost of sending this initiated bill out to referendum will vary according to the total number of referenda enacted during the First Regular Session of the 118th Legislature to be submitted to the voters in November. The estimated cost to the Secretary of State if one to 6 referenda are enacted is \$95,000. Each additional referendum costs an additional \$7,000.'
