Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §685-B, sub-§6-B is enacted to read:

6-B. Notification of land division required. When any land division occurs by platting, sale, lease or other conveyance, regardless of whether a subdivision is created, a plan showing the division of the original parcel must be filed within 60 days of the division, by the person creating the division, with the commission and with the registry of deeds of the county in which the land is located.
