Amend the resolve in section 2 in the 2nd line (page 2, line 5 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "9" and inserting in its place the following: '11'

Further amend the resolve in section 2 in subsection 3 in the 3rd line (page 2, line 18 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "designee," the following: 'the President of the Consulting Engineers of Maine or the president's designee, the President of the Home Builders Association of Maine or the president's designee,'

Further amend the resolve by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The State Planning Office will incur some minor additional costs to staff the Task Force to Study the Desirability of a Model Municipal Building Code. These costs can be absorbed within the office's existing budgeted resources.

The additional costs associated with working with the task force can be absorbed by the Maine State Housing Authority, the Department of Administrative and Financial Services, the
