HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 777, L.D. 1065, Bill, "An Act to Require Law Enforcement Officers to Inform a Person Who Fails to Submit to a Blood Test about the Informed Consent Law"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the title the following:

'Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act to Require Law Enforcement Officers to Inform a Person Who Fails to Submit to a Test about the Informed Consent Law'

Further amend the amendment in subsection 3 in the 3rd line (page 1, line 25 in amendment) by striking out the following: "blood"

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that the refusal to submit applies to other than a blood test only.
