2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. P&SL 1927, c. 43, §7-A, 5th ¶**, as enacted by P&SL 1983,
c. 42, §7, is amended to read:

6 Commencing at the 1984 summer meeting and for even-numbered
8 years thereafter, a nonresident voter shall be elected to serve a
3-year term as overseer. Commencing at the 1985 summer meeting
10 and for odd-numbered years thereafter, a resident voter shall be
12 elected to serve a 3-year term as an overseer. Commencing at the
1997 summer meeting and for each year after the 1997 summer
meeting, any legal voter of the village corporation may be
14 elected for a 3-year term as an overseer if the election of that
overseer does not place all resident or nonresident overseers in
16 office at the same time. A person may run for the office of
overseer for as many terms as that person is nominated. At the
18 first Board of Overseers' meeting following each summer meeting,
they shall choose a chairman chair for the ensuing year.

20 **SUMMARY**

22 This bill amends the charter of the Lucerne-in-Maine Village
24 Corporation to provide that commencing at the 1997 summer meeting
and for each year after the 1997 summer meeting, any legal voter
26 of the village corporation may be elected for a 3-year term as an
overseer if the election of that overseer does not place all
28 resident or nonresident overseers in office at the same time.
The bill also provides that a person may run for the office of
30 overseer for as many terms as that person is nominated.
