	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 17-A MRSA §554-B is enacted to read:

6	§554-B. Solicitation of child by computer to commit unlawful
0	<u>sex act</u>
8	1. A person is guilty of solicitation of a child by a computer if the person is 16 years of age or older and the person
10	knowingly, with the intent to commit an unlawful sex act, entices, advises, coerces, orders or commands, by means of a
12	computer, a child who is less than 16 years of age and at 3 years younger than the defendant, to meet with the defendant or any
14	other person for the purpose of committing an unlawful sex act. As used in this section, the term "computer" has the same meaning
16	as in section 431, subsection 2.
18	2. The offense is committed in this State for purposes of determining jurisdiction if the transmission that constitutes the
20	<u>offense either originates in this State or is received in this State.</u>
22	3. Solicitation of a child by a computer is the same class
24	of crime as the crime solicited.

30	This bill establishes the crime of solicitation of a child by a computer. A person commits this crime if that person is 16 years of age or older and knowingly, with the intent to commit an
32	unlawful sex act, entices, advises, coerces, orders or commands, by means of a computer, a child who is less than 16 years of age
34	and at least 3 years younger than the defendant, to meet with the defendant or any other person for the purpose of committing an
36	unlawful sex act. Solicitation of a child by a computer is the same class of crime as the crime solicited.
