COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 328, L.D. 1106, Bill, "An Act to Increase Access to Education, Training and Employment for Displaced Homemakers"

Amend the bill in section 1 in the last blocked paragraph in the last line (page 1, line 25 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "outcomes." the following: 'Included in this appropriation are funds for resource centers in Millinocket and the St. John Valley.'

Further amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

**'Sec. 2. Department of Labor; rename program.** The following program in the Department of Labor is renamed as follows: "Displaced Homemakers Program" to "Maine Centers for Women, Work and Community." '

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:
