An Act Regarding Medicaid Reimbursement for Nursing Facility Care.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §3174-I, sub-§4 is enacted to read:

4. Reserve occupancy. If a person has been determined to be eligible for nursing facility services under the provisions of this section, has begun residence in a nursing facility and has moved to another residence temporarily, the person retains eligibility when absent for a reasonable period of time. During the person's temporary absence the nursing facility shall reserve occupancy for the person and the department shall reimburse the nursing facility for the person's reserved occupancy at a rate equal to the rate of reimbursement for residential care facilities licensed under this Title. The department shall adopt rules to carry out this subsection. Rules adopted pursuant to this subsection are major substantive rules as defined by Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter II-A.

SUMMARY

This bill allows a nursing facility resident who is determined eligible for Medicaid and who is temporarily absent from the facility to reserve occupancy for a reasonable period of time and provides for payment to the nursing facility at the rate paid for residential care.
