Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §1304, sub-§2, ¶I is enacted to read:

I. The Secretary of State may not issue an instruction permit to a person who has failed a motor vehicle driving test.

SUMMARY

This bill prohibits the Secretary of State from issuing an instruction permit for a motorcycle, motor-driven cycle or moped to a person who has failed a motor vehicle driving test.
