As used in this chapter, the term "occupational disease" means only--a-disease--that-is-due-to-causes--and-conditions

This bill defines the term "occupational disease" to mean any abnormal condition or disorder caused in whole or in part by exposure to environmental factors associated with employment for purposes of the Occupational Disease Law.
