HOUSE AMENDMENT "K" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 832, L.D. 1137, Bill, "An Act Making Unified Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government, General Fund and Other Funds, and Changing Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1998 and June 30, 1999"

Amend the amendment by inserting before the emergency clause the following:

PART XX

Sec. XX-1. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Part.

Deappropriates funds as an adjustment to section A-25 to eliminate funding for the Maine School of Science and Mathematics.

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment will decrease the General Fund cost of the bill by \$1,355,692 in fiscal year 1997-98 and \$1,400,525 in fiscal year 1998-99.

SUMMARY

The amendment eliminates funding for the Maine School of Science and Mathematics and appropriates those amounts to the General Purpose Aid for Local Schools to increase school subsidies.
