Appropriation. The Sec. following funds appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Part. 1997-98 1998-99

Senate amendment " ${\cal G}$ " to committee amendment "A" to H.P. 832, L.D. 1137

SUMMARY

This amendment deappropriates \$500,000 in fiscal year 1997-98 and fiscal year 1998-99 from the Maine Economic Improvement Strategy and appropriates these same amounts for additional community-based services to children with mental retardation and children with mental health needs.

The amendment also removes the authority for the Maine 10 Economic Improvement Strategy to receive up to \$2,000,000 from available balances at the close of fiscal year 1997-98 and 12 substitutes the funding of additional community-based services to children with mental retardation and children with mental health 14 needs.
