COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 838, L.D. 1143, "Resolve, to Name the New Topsham-Brunswick Bridge across the Androscoggin"

Amend the resolve by striking out everything after the title and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. Merrymeeting Bridge. Resolved: That the new bridge spanning the Androscoggin River between the Town of Topsham and the Town of Brunswick be named the "Merrymeeting Bridge" and that a plaque, designed and created by the towns of Topsham and Brunswick, be erected by the Department of Transportation near the bridge.'

Further amend the resolve by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The Department of Transportation will incur some minor additional costs to erect a plaque. These costs can be absorbed within the Department of Transportation's existing budgeted resources.'
