COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 855, L.D. 1160, "RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine to Establish 4-year Terms for Constitutional Officers"

Amend the resolution in Article V, Part Second, Section 1 by striking out all of Section 1 (page 1, lines 7 to 11 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'Section 1. Election; limit on terms. The Secretary of State shall ~~must~~ be chosen biennially every 4 years at the first session of the Legislature, by joint ballot of the Senators and Representatives in convention. A person may not serve more than 2 consecutive terms as Secretary of State.'

Further amend the resolution in Article V, Part Third, Section 1 by striking out all of Section 1 (page 1, lines 15 to 18 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'Section 1. Election; limit on terms. The Treasurer shall ~~must~~ be chosen biennially, every 4 years at the first session of the Legislature, by joint ballot of the Senators, and Representatives in convention. A person may not serve more than 2 consecutive terms as Treasurer of State.'

Further amend the resolution in Article IX, Section 11 by striking out all of Section 11 (page 1, lines 22 to 29 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:
