SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 347, L.D. 1166, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Membership of the Maine Land Use Regulation Commission"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in the first paragraph in the last line (page 2, line 3 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "jurisdiction" the following: 'or be residents of towns abutting the commission's jurisdiction'

SUMMARY

The committee amendment provides that at least 4 members of the Maine Land Use Regulation Commission must be residents within the commission's jurisdiction. This amendment provides that those members may be residents of towns abutting the commission's jurisdiction.
