Sec. 1. University of Maine System; reorganization of governance and coordination structure. Resolved: That the governance and coordination structure of the University of Maine System is reorganized. The reorganization is as follows.

The existing Board of Trustees of the University of 1. Maine System is replaced by a coordinating board. The Coordinating Board of the University of Maine System, referred to in this resolve as the "coordinating board," has the same number and composition of members and those members are appointed in the 10 same manner as the current board of trustees.

Each of the 7 campuses of the University of Maine System 2. has its own board of trustees consisting of 12 members appointed by the Governor.

3. The current chancellor and campus presidents are 18 retained.

20 4. The coordinating board has final budget authority for the University of Maine System and the board of trustees of each campus shall make recommendations regarding the university budget. 22

The board of trustees of each campus has policy 24 5. authority in all other areas of decision making regarding the academic and administrative affairs of the campus, subject to the 26 final approval of the coordinating board.

The board of trustees of each campus shall also support б. fund-raising efforts to sustain and increase the endowment of the 30 campus; and be it further

Sec. 2. Legislative Council; draft legislation to reorganize the governance structure of the system. Resolved: That the Legislative 34 Council shall direct the Legislature's nonpartisan staff to draft legislation that may revise provisions of the charter of the 36 University of Maine System and the Maine Revised Statutes as necessary to accomplish the reorganization of the governance 38 structure; and be it further

Sec. 3. Office of the chancellor; assistance. Resolved: That upon 42 request, the staff of the office of the Chancellor of the University of Maine System, the Department of Education, the State Board of Education and the Joint Standing Committee on 44 Education shall provide assistance to the staff of the 46 Legislative Council in preparing legislation; and be it further

Sec. 4. Report. Resolved: That the Executive Director of the 48 Legislative Council shall provide draft legislation to the 50 Legislative Council by December 1, 1997.

reorganization of the governance and coordination The 6 structure of the University of Maine System is a significant public policy concern for the State. A policy-making arrangement 8 that achieves the proper balance between the common system-wide needs of the University of Maine System and the distinct needs of the individual campuses is a critical factor in providing 10 effective and efficient public higher education for the State and 12 the people of Maine. This resolve requires the Legislative Council with the assistance from the Office of the Chancellor of the University of Maine System, the Department of Education, the 14 State Board of Education and the Joint Standing Committee on Education to draft legislation that reorganizes the governance 16 and coordination structure of the University of Maine System by replacing the Board of Trustees of the University of Maine System 18 with a coordinating board and 7 campus boards of trustees.
