22	Amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all of the last sentence (page 1, lines 12 to 16 in L.D.) and inserting in its
24	place the following: 'The plan must provide for the department to have cost estimates for appropriate facilities and certified
26	staff to perform the following tests:
28	1. EHD-SN;
30	2. Vesicular Stomatitis: SN;
32	3. Leptospirosis - 5 serotypes;
34	4. VS CF; and
36	5. BVD/IBR.
38	The department shall provide an estimate of costs associated with testing capability for the EHD-SN Test and cumulative cost
40	estimates associated with developing testing capability for each
42	of the other 4 tests. Throughout the development of the plan, the department shall consult with potential users of the testing
44	program, including, but not limited to, the following: a Maine farmer engaged in the export of live animals and embryos,
46	representatives of the harness racing and poultry industries and a person with recognized expertise in biotechnology. The Joint Standing Committee on Amigultume Componential and Fourier and
48	Standing Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry may report to the Second Regular Session of the 118th Legislature
50	legislation relating to testing of live animals and embryos for export from the State.'

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 355, L.D. 1174

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Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

## **FISCAL NOTE**

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The Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources will incur some minor additional costs to develop and submit a required report to the Legislature. These costs can be absorbed 10 within the department's existing budgeted resources.'

## SUMMARY

16 This amendment specifies the tests that the plan developed by the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources must 18 include. It requires the department to provide cost estimates associated with testing capabilities for the 5 tests. It 20 requires the department to consult with a variety of potential users of the test program and with an expert in the field of 22 biotechnology. This amendment also adds a fiscal note.
