24	SUMMARY
26	This amendment clarifies the role of representatives of
28	appropriate state service agencies participating in transition planning with pupil evaluation teams. The amendment corrects several references and changes the date to June 30, 1999, at
3.0	which time the state service agencies must show evidence of having used the data compiled in accordance with the bill to
32	develop their budget requests.

The amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
