COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 882, L.D. 1199, Bill, "An Act to Ensure Adequate Nutrition and Support for Low-income Legal Immigrants"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the title and before the enacting clause (page 1, lines 1 to 26 in L.D.)

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~S3104-A.~~" by striking out all of subsection 4 (page 2, lines 6 to 12 in L.D.)

Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 9 by striking out all of paragraph C (page 2, lines 36 to 43 in L.D.)

Further amend the bill by inserting after section 2 the following:

Sec. 3. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Provides funds for a monthly food benefit to certain legal immigrants and related costs.

30 The Department of Human Services will incur additional costs
 32 to provide supplemental income and a monthly food benefit to

 1998-99, \$801,284 in fiscal year 1999-2000 and \$963,092 in fiscal
 36 year 2000-01. General Fund appropriations in these amounts will
 be required to fund the costs associated with these benefits.'

38 **SUMMARY**

40 This amendment deletes the emergency preamble and the
 42 emergency clause. It deletes the notice provisions in the food
 assistance and the supplemental security income sections. The
 44 amendment also adds an appropriation section and fiscal note.
