Appoint a state natural resource agency official to serve as an ex officio member of the federal Aquatic Nuisance Species Task Force established under the federal Aquatic Nuisance Prevention and Control Act, 16 United States Code, Section 4721; and

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2. Prepare and submit a state aquatic nuisance species management plan in accordance with the federal Aquatic Nuisance Prevention and Control Act, 16 United States Code, Section 4724.

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16 SUMMARY

This resolve requires the Governor to appoint an ex officio member to the federal Aquatic Nuisance Species Task Force to address issues related primarily to ballast water. The resolve also requires the Governor to prepare and submit to the task force a state aquatic nuisance species management plan.
