Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 17-A MRSA §506-A, sub-§§1-A and 1-B are enacted to 4 read:

6 1-A. In addition to the prohibition specified in subsection 1, an adult person in the custody of the Department of 8 Corrections is guilty of harassment if, without reasonable cause, that person engages in any course of conduct with the intent to 10 harass, torment or threaten another person, after having been forbidden to do so by the Commissioner of Corrections or the 12 chief administrative officer of the facility housing the person or the designee of either.

1-B. In addition to the prohibition specified in subsection 1, an adult person under the supervision of the Department of Corrections is guilty of harassment if, without reasonable cause, 18 that person engages in any course of conduct with the intent to harass, torment or threaten another person, after having been 20 forbidden to do so by the Commissioner of Corrections or the regional correctional administrator or the designee of either. 22

SUMMARY

26 This bill provides that an adult person in the custody of the Department of Corrections may be forbidden to engage in harassment by the Commissioner of Corrections or the chief 28 administrative officer of the facility housing the adult person 30 their designees as well as a sheriff, deputy sheriff, or constable, police officer, justice of the peace or a court. It also provides that an adult person under the supervision of the 32 Department of Corrections may be forbidden to engage in harassment by the commissioner or the regional correctional 34 administrator or their designees.
